CHILDHOOD

- She was a happy and naughty toddler.
- During her first years in the Netherlands, Anne suffered from health problems.
- Anne is very cheerful, but also sensitive and nervous.
- She was very popular because she always had plans for games they could play.
- Anne liked to be the centre of attention.
- In October 1942, 13 year old Anne dreamed of a career as a movie star in Hollywood.
- Her greatest wish to publish a book about the time she was in hiding.



SISTER MARGOT

- She was born in Frankfurt am Main on 16 February 1926.
- She was older than her sister Anna.
- She was good at a math.
- She was supposed to report to work camp but her parents hid her.
- She wished she had become a midwife.
- Died of illness in February 1945.



MOVING

- Anne's parents were worried about future in Frankfurt.
- They are worried about the attitude of the Nazis to the Jews.
- In the year 1933 - Otto moved to Amsterdam and started with his company.
- Anne and Margot stayed with their grandmother.
- In the year 1934 - Anne and her sister emigrated to Amsterdam.



SCHOOLS

- Margot started school in January and Anne started school in April.
- On 9th April 1934 - Anne went to the kindergarten at the 6th Montessori school in Amsterdam.
- She attended primary school until 1941.
- Later Jews were allowed to attend just Jewish schools.
- Anne went to the Jewish Lyceum and she attended until 1942.



FRIEND HANNAH GOSLAR

- She was born in Berlin-Tiergarten on 12 November 1928.
- She had a younger sister Gabi.
- She was an Israeli nurse.
- Hannah Goslar was one of Anne Frank's best friends.
- She thought Anne and her family had fled to Switzerland.
- She later met Anne in the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp.
- She and her sister survived the war.
- She died on 28 October 2022 at the age of 93 in Jerusalem.



BOYFRIEND PETER VAN PELS – LOVE STORY

- Was hidden in the same place with the Frank family.
- Peter spent a lot of time with Anna and they fell in love.
- They kissed but Anna said he'd never be her boyfriend.
- Peter fell ill and ended up in a sick barracks.
- Peter van Pels died on 10 May 1945 he was 18 years old.
