- Anneliese Marie Frank
- 12. June 1929 Frankfurt
- Parents: Otto Frank, Edith Frank
- Sister: Margot Frank
- Moved to Amsterdam 1934
- The Second World War 1939
- 10. May 1940 Nazis









Hiding in the Secret Annex

- Star of David
- 5. July 1942 call from labour camp
- Parents decided to go into hiding

• Spring of 1942 - Anne's father had started furnishing a hiding

place in the annex







Anne keeps a diary

- On her thirteenth birthday 12. June 1942
- Anne wrote about events in the Secret Annex
- Book of Beautiful Sentences
- Het Achterhuis







The hiding place is discovered

Started rewriting her diary, but before she was done - arrested

4 August 1944

Two other helpers took the documents before the Secret Annex was emptied by

order of the Nazis





Anne is deported to Auschwitz

- Transport to the Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration and extermination camp
- 3 days
- Anne, Margot and their mother were sent to the labour camp for women
- Otto ended up in a camp for men





Anne dies from exhaustion in Bergen-Belsen

- November 1944, Anne was put on transport again
- Parents stayed behind in Auschwitz
- Anne and Margot contracted typhus
- February 1945

Friends convinced Otto to publish the diary and in

June 1947
